The primary function of the State Health Improvement Plan Steering Committee is to develop data-driven strategies for implementing evidence-based, targeted and integrated efforts to improve the health of all Floridians.

**Primary Functions:**

- *Leadership* – Prioritize health issues; review and approve the State Health Assessment and the State Health Improvement Plan; review progress and oversee revisions to the plan annually.
- *Champion* – Advocate for State Health Improvement Plan activities in their respective agencies and organizations, and across the state.
