The primary function of the SHIP Data Subcommittee (Subcommittee) is to monitor and report health-related data indicators, improve systems and timeliness of data reporting, and develop data-driven strategies to improve the health of all Floridians.

The Subcommittee adopted expert recommendations to streamline operations and optimize data usage and implementation, including:

- Standardizing processes and templates by streamlining impactful work with collaborative tools for real-time editing.
- Connecting data sources, where possible, to avoid silos and improve efficiency.
- Using technology platforms and dashboards to render more visually presentable and understandable data for the public.

The Subcommittee identifies gaps in data and data use agreements for SHIP measures and works to establish data sharing among organizations. With the target goal of improving Floridian's health through education, the Subcommittee continues its groundbreaking efforts to optimize data-driven strategies.

Moving forward, the Subcommittee will focus on enhancing collaboration with associated agencies and technology platforms and dashboards to capture, streamline, and aggregate real-time data.
